HAND-LIST OF PERSONAL PAPERS FROM THE MUNIMENTS OF THE EARL OF CRAWFORD AND BALCARRES DEPOSITED IN THE JOHN RYLANDS UNIVERSITY LIBRARY OF MANCHESTER.

In addition to general family correspondence and papers (notably Lindsay, Bradshaigh and Pennington), 16th-19th cent., this *Hand-List* deals with four extensive groupings within the Crawford Papers: (1) official, business and personal correspondence of Alexander, 6th Earl of Balcarres, as Lieutenant Governor of Jamaica, 1794-1801; (2) literary and personal letters, diaries and holograph works of Lady Anne Barnard (*D.N.B.*); among her friends were the Prince Regent, Mrs. Fitzherbert, William Windham and Sir Walter Scott, and, as wife of the Colonial Secretary, she was resident at the Cape of Good Hope within two years of the first British occupation, recording her life there in detail in her Journals; (3) correspondence and papers concerning the development of the collieries and iron works in the Wigan area (late 18th-19th cent.); and (4) important sources for the local historian of Lancashire and of Fife (17th-19th cent.).
