

What can I do?

- Display a list of my publications on my personal website
- Create a CV of my publications
- Easily bookmark and share my work with others
- Generate a list of publications for a grant funders report
- Deposit and access your publications from any internet-enabled computer, add simple or comprehensive metadata describing your work
- Upload and download full text versions of your work
- Upload journal articles, books, book contributions, conference contributions, working papers, reports, images, datasets and other forms of scholarly work
- Import your publication details from existing databases, such as EndNote, Reference Manager, Pub Med and Web of Knowledge
- Export your publication details for offline working
- Create a reliable web address to your work that others cite
- Register a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) for your work
- Upload pre-print and published works (where copyright allows)
- Check publishers standard copyright statements (using SHERPA Romeo)
- Get guidance on new developments in scholarly communication request support and advice

What is Manchester eScholar?

- A locus for individuals to manage, disseminate and share their scholarly work
- A place to store and preserve intellectual assets
- A catalogue of research outputs
- A set of services supporting scholarly communication at The University of Manchester

Who can use eScholar?

- eScholar is available for anyone to use, free of charge
- All University of Manchester staff and postgraduate students may add material to eScholar

Why should I use eScholar?

- To increase the visibility of your research
- As an extension of your personal storage space
- To have a safe, secure and single online point of reference for your work

- To satisfy research council requirements
- To get an indicator of the impact that your research has
- To improve your understanding of copyright and your rights as an author
- To keep abreast of the latest research in The University
- To disseminate non-traditional publications like reports and working papers
